## Recital

Our recital will take place at Eastdale Collegiate (in Oshawa on the south east corner of Adelaide and Harmony) on Sunday, May 24<sup>th</sup> at 1:00pm.

The show will be approximately 3 hours. There will be no supervision other than 5 routines before and after your child's performance.

Tickets will only be sold now at the door the day of recital. **Tickets are not available through your teachers.**

## Recital Costumes

Over the next couple of weeks we will be purchasing costumes and fitting your child. You will receive a note with the balance owing (if any). You will be able to purchase your costumes during the last 2 weeks in May. All class fees must be paid before your costumes can be purchased.

## Hair & Make-Up for Recital and Picture Day

Young dancers (7 years and under) need light make up: blush and lipstick.

Older students may wear eye liner, eye shadow, mascara, blush, and lipstick.

For jazz, tap, hip hop, and acro: hair must be pulled back off the face in a straight low ponytail with a left side part. Please use gel and hairspray to keep hair secure. Hair accessories (if any) should be secured with bobby pins if needed.

All ballet students: Bun with a left side part.

Mini Dancers (Pre-Ballet Level 1, Jazz/Tap age 3-4, and Pre-Ballet Level 2...all Saturday morning classes from 9:00 am – 10:30 am) can wear their hair how they wish. However, please remember to have their hair pulled off their face.

## Recital DVD's

An order form will be handed out in a few weeks. All DVD's will be shipped to the studio within 2-3 weeks after the recital and can be picked up during fall pre-registration and summer registration. Individual phone calls will not go out to students ordering videos. A recorded message on our answering machine stating that the video's are in will be left when received. It will also be posted on our website.

## Recital Student Information

Students are to be brought backstage 5 routines before their class performance. Our recital order will be handed out with your costume pricing. Students are to be picked up immediately after they perform (signs will be posted at Eastdale for pick up and drop off locations). Dressing rooms will be designated by age group.

Recreational students that perform within the first 15 routines of the recital are to arrive no later than 12:30pm. All other recreational students can arrive for the start of the show (1:00).

All competitive students are to be at Eastdale by 12:00 noon.

All students are welcome to join us onstage for finale. Students are to be brought backstage during the last performance and we will organize them by age from there. If your child will be joining us for finale, you are to pick them back up from the stage after the curtains have closed.
